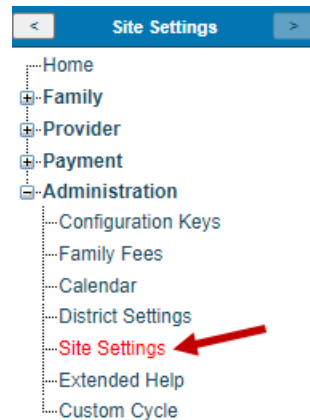


KinderTrack – Viewing the Site Settings Page

The **Site Settings** page affects the internal operation of many KinderTrack functions and reports. Some values are set during deployment and cannot be changed.

- A** Press the **Site Settings** page under **Administration**.

- B** The System Administrator can modify some of the values that affect the preferences governing the system's functions. Scroll to review.
