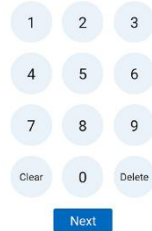


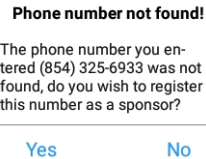
KinderSign – How to Create a Parent/Sponsor PIN and Secret Question/Answer

If you are logging into KinderSign for the first time, you need to create some security settings to verify your identity.

A Use the keypad to enter your 10-digit telephone number. Tap **Next**.

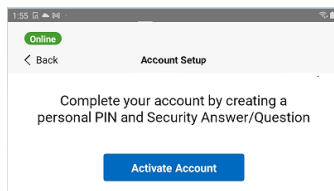


B If the tablet does not recognize the telephone number, you will receive a message informing you that it was entered not found and asking if you would like to register that number as a Parent/Sponsor.

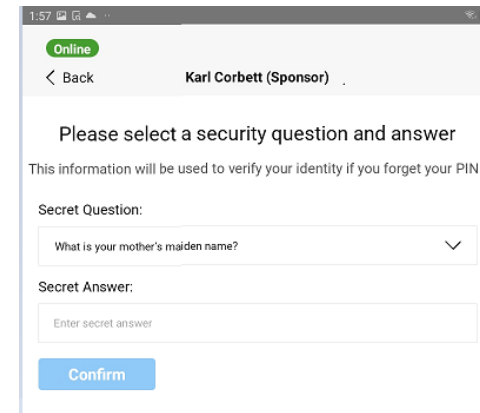


C Tap **Yes** to refresh the device automatically with the latest information or **No** to re-enter the telephone number. If the message still appears after refreshing, then the phone number doesn't exist in the system.

D Once updated, you will receive a message indicating that your security settings are incomplete. Tap **Next**.



E Tap the drop-down arrow to select the Secret Question you want to use to verify your identity. Tap on the **Secret Answer** field and enter the secret answer. Tap **Confirm**.



F KinderSign returns to the keypad to create your **PIN**. Enter your 6 to 8-digit **PIN** and tab **Next**. Re-enter the 6 to 8-digit **PIN** and tab **Verify** to confirm.



Note: PIN must not have consecutive or repeated numbers (ex: 123456 or 111469).

G KinderSign returns to the telephone keypad and is ready for you to login using your telephone number and new **PIN**.
